Program description

The undergraduate certificate in Healthcare Environmental and Hospitality Services consists of 15 credit hours. The certificate is designed to enable hospitality and healthcare industry professionals and students to understand the environmental and hospitality services in the healthcare industry.

The anticipated certificate was launched in Spring 2018 with the first of three course, *Introduction to Healthcare Environmental and Hospitality Services*. This is a three-credit hour online course. There are four required EVS courses to earn this planned certificate.
