Compare the EPA Reg. No. on the product's label with the EPA Registration Number on List N.

Find the EPA Registration Number (Reg. No.) on the product's label, usually on the back toward the bottom.

**Match
the number,
not the
name**

Products may be marketed and sold under different names, but if they have the same first two sets of EPA Registration Numbers, they are related.

12345-67
and
12345-67-890
are related

If EPA Reg. No. 12345-67 is on List N, you can buy EPA Reg. No. 12345-67-890 and use the same contact time directions from List N.
