Reminders for Application Submission

☐ Collaboration across departments

- Complete the application thoroughly.
 - Ensure all required sections are filled out with relevant details.
- Avoid being too vague.
 - While brevity is appreciated, include enough information to clearly describe your program.
- Avoid excessive detail.
 - Keep documentation concise—aim for 2–3 pages rather than lengthy narratives.
- Make your explanation accessible.
 - Describe your program in a way that someone outside your field can understand. You're showcasing why your department stands out.
- Get feedback before submitting.
 - Ask a trusted colleague to review your submission to ensure your message is clear and compelling.

Application submissions will open in early 2026!
